<p>Elevator Pitch: What's so great about Depth & Complexity? Let me tell you! Create a comprehensive 30-second elevator pitch explaining why the D&C Framework is the best differentiation tool. Need a little help? Check out THIS tutorial. Record yourself and share the video.</p>	<p>Comprehensive Plan: Now that you have completed the synchronous and asynchronous portions of this cohort - what's next? Develop a comprehensive plan explaining how you will integrate all of the pieces of the Depth & Complexity Framework into your current position. Provide a timeline for the rest of the year or the following year and explain expected outcomes in a few paragraphs.</p>	<p>30-60 min. Staff Mtg: You've been tasked with teaching your staff about the Depth & Complexity Framework in an after school meeting? Great! Create a presentation that you would share with a group of teachers. Share your goals of the presentation and expected outcomes. Bonus points if you choose to record yourself presenting the training with a screen-sharing extension such as Screencastify.</p>
<p>Leading a PLC: You're in charge? What a perfect way to use the Depth & Complexity Framework with your colleagues! Create an outline of how you would incorporate D&C in meaningful ways to lead your PLC for the rest of the year or the coming year. Be sure to include a timeline, 2-3 example meeting agendas, and a few paragraphs explaining expected outcomes.</p>	<p>Course Reflection: We are grateful that you chose to spend your time digging deeper into the Depth & Complexity Framework and would love to hear your feedback. Tell us how D&C has changed the way you approach your position and your plans for the future. Provide some anecdotal evidence as to how D&C has changed learning for students. Do you have a suggestion or idea? We want to hear that, too!</p>	<p>Differentiation with D&C: Teachers everywhere struggle with understanding how to meaningfully differentiate learning experiences for their students. Tell us how you plan to use the Depth & Complexity Framework to differentiate for your students - or how you would support a teacher looking to differentiate. Provide a sample lesson and a few relection paragraphs explaining expected outcomes.</p>
<p>3-6 Hour PD: You're lucky enough to have a captive audience for ½ a day or more? Fantastic! Create a 3-6 hour professional development presentation on the Depth & Complexity Framework. This can be an introduction training or an overview - your choice! Be sure to add a slide explaining your goals as a presenter and expected outcomes.</p>	<p>15 min Hallway Conversation: Passing by a teacher in the hallway that wonders what those rainbow icons are in your room? Wonderful! Script what you would share about the Depth & Complexity Framework and how its implementation has positively affected your students' learning experiences. What are the main points you want to make so that the teacher walks away from your conversation convinced that D&C is a great pedagogical tool?</p>	<p>Ongoing Support: Are you in a position where you are mentoring or supporting another teacher? Fabulous! How do you plan to leverage your newfound knowledge of the Depth & Complexity Framework with teachers? Outline your strategy for integrating D&C in meaningful ways to support teachers and students. Develop some talking points, ideas, and action items that detail your approach. In 2-3 paragraphs, reflect on your expected outcomes.</p>
